What is ECCLC's Role in UPK Colorado?

Early Childhood Council of Larimer County (ECCLC) was named the Local Coordinating Organization (LCO) for Larimer County. We are thrilled and look forward to being the lead organization in implementing universal pre-kindergarten (UPK) in our community.

A local coordinating organization is a community agency or organization that is responsible for supporting access and equitable delivery of early childhood and family support programs and services, fostering partnerships, creating alignment, and establishing a comprehensive, locally supported plan for providing early childhood and family support programs equitably within a given community.

What is UPK Colorado?

Universal Preschool (UPK) Colorado ensures that every child in the year before they are eligible for kindergarten is eligible for half-day (15 hours) of state-funded, voluntary preschool beginning in the 2023-24 school year. Threeyear-olds with qualifying factors are eligible for part-time (10 hours) of preschool programming.

How is UPK Colorado Funded?

The launch of this program is a result of the voter-approved Proposition EE. This Proposition was designed to increase cigarette and tobacco product taxes incrementally and create a new tax on nicotine products. Revenues from this tax are dedicated to education programs.

FAMILIES

- Every child in the year before they are eligible for kindergarten qualifies for half-day (15 hours) of state-funded preschool.
- Families are given the opportunity to choose from a variety of high quality, preschool programs in Larimer County, whether that be through the school system, a community center, or a family home provider (known as a mixed delivery system).
- Families could save up to 5K+ a year in high quality preschool programming.
